Quay FM confirm place in Bailiwick Broadcasting DAB line up

Alderney's Quay FM, the only community radio station in the Channel Islands, has confirmed its place on Bailiwick Broadcasting's recently submitted application to Ofcom for the Channel Islands DAB digital radio multiplex.

A wholly owned subsidiary of Nation Broadcasting, the UK's third largest local radio operator proposes, in its submission to Ofcom, comprehensive DAB coverage for each of the individual Channel Islands. The existing stations' FM coverage areas will be matched on DAB together with a comprehensive line up of 25 additional services, catering for the widest possible range of tastes and interests in the Channel Islands.

Colin Mason, CEO of Quay FM said "Quay FM on Alderney is supportive of DAB broadcasting. The Directors of Quay FM have discussed Bailiwick's commitment to simulcast our FM service on DAB and considers that this would be a great boost to our current and future broadcasting services. We are pleased to confirm that we will be on DAB from day one."

Ash Elford, Nation Broadcasting's DAB Platform Manager, said "Bailiwick Broadcasting will guarantee that the people of Alderney will not be left behind in the digital radio revolution. We can guarantee equivalent coverage on DAB for Alderney's existing BBC and commercial services and, as one of the 25 services, Quay FM will help us achieve our goal of bringing choice, variety and opportunity to the Channel Islands radio market".
